FISH Food Pantry has been operating for the past 30 years out of various locations throughout McHenry. Currently we are serving over 400 families a month out of the 1200 sf basement of the township building and storing food in an off-site storage facility just a few miles away. Since the transition of leadership this past summer, we have been working on a new approach so that no child or adult in our community has to go hungry.

Our recent partnership with the Northern Illinois
Food Bank has allowed us to participate in the
(EFP) Emergency Food Program (offering free
commodities of fresh & frozen foods) in addition
to also purchasing food at a price of \$.14 /lb. It
has been a wonderful opportunity for us to give a
little more to our clients during these tough times.
The volunteers at FISH continue to work together
to feed our disadvantaged neighbors in need!
