40 years ago, FISH of McHenry Food Pantry was chartered and organized in 1973 to help serve the disadvantaged in our community. Looking back at our humble beginnings and the temporary locations used over the years, it is amazing to think that we are still thriving and able to help our hungry neighbors in need. We would never have been able to achieve this if not for the generous support of our community & the many dedicated volunteers who have served to keep us open each week. Our new food pantry has truly been a blessing this past year as we are able to purchase & store so many more choices to offer to our clients. For every \$1.00 donation to FISH Food Pantry, we can buy approximately 10 lbs. of food from Northern Illinois Food Bank.


