## 2014 Thanksgiving Holiday Meals

The statistics from the Hunger in America Study prove that there are many individuals and families still struggling with the current economy and seeking food assistance. The number of clients we are serving continues to grow with totals averaging now over 700 families per month. The holidays can be a stressful time to those facing hunger and on a limited budget. It is our goal to make sure these households receive a warm meal as they gather together with family and friends to celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday.

This year, FISH of McHenry will be purchasing 425 Holiday Meal Boxes from the Northern Illinois Food Bank. Holiday Boxes include a 12-14 lb. frozen turkey and all of the fixings for a complete meal. In addition, we have been stocking up on traditional Thanksgiving favorite foods to fill 300 bags for smaller families. These bags also include the fixings for an entire meal and a frozen turkey breast roast purchased by FISH of McHenry.

A donation of just \$25.00 covers the costs of 3 meals; 1 Holiday Meal Box and 2 Holiday Meal Bags. Donating is as easy as the click of the **Donate** Button on our website at www.fishofmchenry.org. # **Hunger in America 2014 Study**

The Hunger in America 2014 study, conducted by Feeding America, is completed every four years, surveying the food pantries and feeding programs in the Northern Illinois Food Bank network and the people who seek food assistance from them. Listed below is a snapshot of the individuals NIFB serves:

- 40% identify as white
- 33% identify as Hispanic or Latino
- 17% identify as black or African American
- 36% are children under age 18
- 15% are adults age 18 29
- 26% are adults from age 30 49
- 13% are adults age 50 59
- 9% are seniors age 60 and older
- 66% of households have incomes that fall at or below the federal poverty level
- 45% of households have annual incomes of \$10,000 or less

Of households within the past 12 months:

- 77% have a member that has worked for pay
- 23% did not have employment but include members in the household who are retired, disabled, in poor health or caretakers
- 77% reported they had to choose between paying for food and utilities
- 69% chose between paying for food and transportation
- 62% chose between paying for food and paying for medicine at least once
- 62% chose between paying for food and paying for housing at least once
